Qualification for **Veteran Gold Cup Final** requires an excellent with CK in either exhibition 1 or 2

The 4 best babies from exhibition 1 and 2 with Very Promising will qualify for **Best Baby Gold Cup Final**





The 4 best puppies from exhibition 1 and 2 with Very Promising will qualify for **Best puppy Gold Cup Final**

The 4 best males and 4 best females from exhibition 1 and 2 will qualify for the **Gold Cup Final** (Official Class)

Exhibition tents:

Tents can be put up from Tuesday 16th July at 16:00

Exhibition tents measuring up to 6x3 meters, can be put up for free in the marked areas on a first come first served basis.

Tents bigger than 3x6 meters and smaller than 35m2 can be put up for free in the area for larger

tents, but **only** by prior agreement from Newfoundland Club Denmark. Please send request to: <u>showentry@newfclub.dk</u>

Tents bigger than 35 m2 can only be put up by both prior agreement and payment to Newfoundland Club Denmark

There is limited access to electricity. Access can be bought for 75DKK per day or 250 DKK for the whole period.

Under no circumstances are people or dogs allowed to overnight in the exhibition tents in the exhibition area

Dog Walking:

All dogs must be kept on a leach and must be walked **<u>outside</u>** of the exhibition areas and exhibition tents.

Please clean up after your dog!

We appeal to everybody to help keep all areas clean and tidy. If you see that someone has forgotten to "pick up" then please do so, there will be plenty of bins available.

<u>Camping</u>

There will be access to the camping area from Tuesday at 12 pm for everybody, who has pre-booked. On arrival you will met by one by Newfoundland Club Denmark representatives, who are all wearing pink vests.

They will check your booking and issue you with a "Camping Sign". The Sign has to be displayed on you accommodation.

If you arrive during the night, or are unable to locate a member of staff, then please find a member of the Staff, at the first opportunity.

Please remember to bring electrical extension leads, as the electricity supply, can be places quite far away.





All pitches will be allocated on a "first come – first served" basis. Pitches can not be reserved, and neither be held for people, who will arrive at a later date. Please respect that some pitches are held as disabled pitches.

<u>Vet</u>

In case you need a Veterinarian, then please contact: Herning Dyrehospital Hedelandsvej 27 7400 Herning Phone: 97 12 77 20 (24 hrs)

A vet from Herning Dyrehospital will try to be present on Saturday, to certify de-worming in passports. If a vet is not able to attend, then an appointment will be made for all Norwegian and Finnish exhibitors to visit the clinic – this will be after judging. The vet is located 2 km from Gold Cup. If you need to have your de-worming certified, then please contact chairman for The Newfoundland Club Denmark - Michele Utke Ramsing as soon as possible.

Be responsible – it's summer and probably quite hot

It is forbidden to put you dog in a situation, which could be detrimental for its health and wellbeing. This includes leaving your dog in a hot car, tent or caravan. Cruel treatment of you dog will not be tolerated.

Please be prepared for hot weather and think ahead on how to create suitable conditions for your dog by using cooling blankets or ventilators. Many ventilators run on battery but alternatively you can buy access to electricity for 75 DKK per day or 250 DKK for the whole period.

Remember to:

- Print the attached starting number and bring it with you on the day of exhibition
- Vaccination certificate, Pedigree (only non-danish dogs), pin for start number, waterbowl, perhaps a chair or anything else, which might help make the days more comfortable.
- Vaccination certificate must be shown if asked. If you are bringing dogs, who are not being exhibited, then please also bring their vaccination certificate.
- Please take precautions if your females are in heat and show consideration towards the males
- Please clean up after yourselves and your Newfies.
