Qualification for **the Junior handler Gold Cup Final** are the 4 best junior handlers from Exhibition 1 and the 4 best junior handlers from Exhibition 2

Qualification for **the Veteran Gold Cup final** is excellent with CK at either Exhibition 1 or Exhibition 2

Qualification for **the Baby Gold Cup final** are the 4 best babies from Exhibition 1 and the 4 best babies from Exhibition 2 with very promising

Qualification for **the Puppies Gold Cup final** are the 4 best puppies from Exhibition 1 and the 4 best puppies from Exhibition 2 with very promising

Qualification for **the Gold Cup final (official class)** are the 4 best males and the 4 best bitches from Exhibition 1 and the 4 best males and the 4 best bitches from Exhibition 2

Exhibition tents:

Exhibition tents of up to 3x3 meters may be freely set in the areas marked with belt bands. Tents larger than 3x3 meters and less than 30 m² can be set up free of charge in the designated areas, but ONLY after prior agreement with the Newfoundland club. Send mail to showentry@newfclub.dk

Tents larger than 30 m² must not be used. Power access is purchased at the campsite.

Under no circumstances may people or dogs sleep in the exhibition tents in the exhibition area.

Campsite and exhibition area:

It is possible to purchase access to electricity from the campsite.

Use of blower and the like during assessments must be done in a suitable distance to the ring so that it does not interfere with the assessments.

NOTE All dogs MUST be kept on leash and must be walked OUTSIDE the campsite area. Remember to clean up after yourself and your dogs!

REMEMBER:

- To print the attached starting number and bring it on the exhibition date.
- Vaccination certificate, pedigree log, pin for number plate, water bowl, treats and possibly a chair.
- Vaccination certificate must be presented on request. In case you bring dogs which are not to be exhibited, vaccination certificate is also included.
- Be aware of the dogs if your bitch is in heat.
- Clean up after yourself and your Newf
